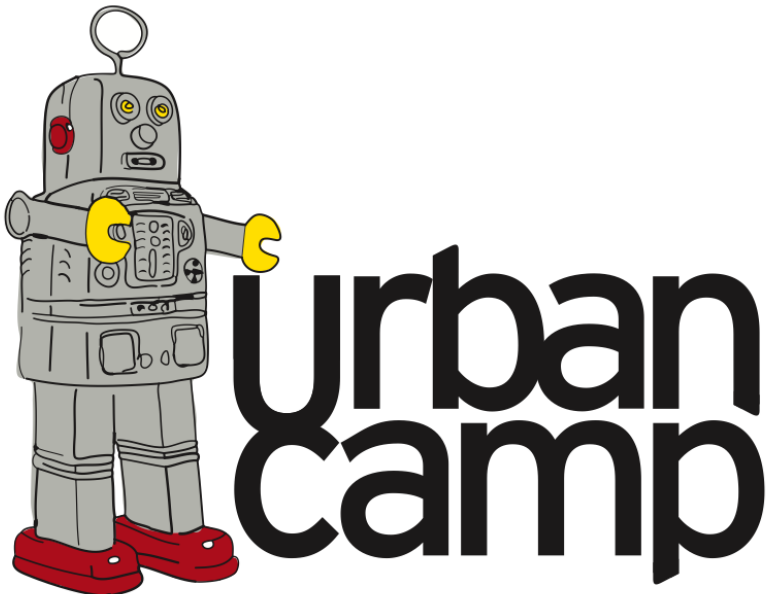


# Amazing Race Portland

# Amazing Race Portland FAQs

## What is this all about?

This year's Amazing Race is Urban Camp's fourth annual race around Portland. Designed after the TV show "The Amazing Race", we have reproduced what could quite possibly be the most amazing thing going on in Portland on August 7, 2010. Teams of three or four (your choice) will travel throughout the city, following clues to each destination, with various challenges awaiting you. There will be pit stops throughout the race where some teams will be eliminated and other teams will move on until the last few teams arrive at the finish line! All finishers, eliminated teams, and volunteers will join at the finish line at the end of the day for a free celebration dinner.

## What will I be doing?

You'll spend the entire day going buck wild all around the city of Portland - but never breaking any city laws. Throughout the day you will find yourselves participating in mental and physical challenges. Each challenge will be specific to how many team members participate. Compete to stay at the front of the pack; those who lag behind may be eliminated.

## Lunch?

Pack a sack lunch... We'll take a longer break at one of our pit stops to eat.

## What are participants responsible for?

Providing your own team, sack lunch, water, and safety.

## What if a player decides to drop out mid-race?

If one team member drops out of the race, the team is forced to forfeit. Choose teammates wisely.

## What are the risks?

Much of the day will include physical activity and the risk on a hot August day is exhaustion. Please bring and drink a ton of water. If any injury does occur while participating in The Amazing Race, Mosaic is not responsible. You are playing at your own risk. Signing below waives Mosaic of any responsibility. Also, please memorize the LAW BREAKERS rule below.

**LAW BREAKERS:** For all law breakers out there...this is not an event where this will be tolerated. If players are caught doing anything illegally, the team will be forced to forfeit. If team members make poor choices in strategy that break the law or break the rules of the day, your team will be forfeited. This is your one and only warning.
